Regulations on Doctoral Qualifying Exam Exemption

I. After being admitted to the GINM, Doctoral students who have satisfied the following conditions are eligible to apply for Doctoral Qualifying Exam exemption, while its approval will be determined by the Committee of Academic Affairs of GINM.

1. By taking courses

Doctoral students who have taken courses acknowledged as topics for Doctoral Qualifying Exam and whose grade is above A+ and among the top 20% of the students enrolled in the class (if the class consists of less than 5 students, the top 20% of all students will be considered as 1 with the approval of the professor) are eligible to apply for Doctoral Qualifying Exam exemption. (Application submitted over one year after accomplishing the course will not be processed.)

2. By publishing papers

Doctoral students who have published papers in related areas are eligible to apply for the Qualifying Exam exemption. The Committee of Academic Affairs of GINM shall evaluate the relativity of the papers. However, the main content of the paper should be based on the research conducted after being admitted to the Doctoral Program of GINM (except for students admitted through Direct Admission to Doctoral Program) and the student has to be the main contributor of the paper. If, before the deadline of the Qualifying Exam, a doctoral student has had any paper published (accepted paper included), he is eligible to apply for Qualifying Exam exemption based on following procedures.

- (1) Students who have any paper published in top international journals or conferences acknowledged by the Committee of Academic Affairs are eligible to apply for the

exemption of at most two kernel courses.

(2) Students who have any paper published in good international journals or conferences acknowledged by the Committee of Academic Affairs are eligible to apply for the exemption of one kernel course.

3. Through system implementation

Doctoral students is eligible to apply for qualification exam if they can successfully implemented a system of practical values and if the implementation starts after the applicant has entered the doctoral program of GINM. Relevant materials should be submitted to the GINM committee of academic affairs for approval before the deadline of the qualifying exam. The applicant has to be the main contributor if the system is implemented by multiple persons.

II. CSIE students who have passed topics for the Doctoral Qualifying Exam of CSIE or GINM is eligible to apply for Qualifying Exam exemption.

III. The Committee of Academic Affairs will hold a meeting to review the applications before the Doctoral Qualifying Exam in every semester.
